WHEN GRAFFITI IS "OCCURRING NOW"

If you are a witness to graffiti or vandalism as it is happening, call 9-1-1 immediately. Give as much information as you can about the suspects and the location.

WHEN GRAFFITI APPEARS

If you see graffiti in the neighborhood, on your property or someone else's, report it as soon as possible, to the Graffiti Removal Hotline at (951) 817-5841.



WHAT IS GRAFFITI?

GRAFFITI is defined as writing, drawing or symbols applied to any surface without the consent of the property owner, or authorized agent.

Graffiti has a negative effect on a resident's feeling of safety in their neighborhood. It creates a perception (whether factual or not) that crime is on the rise and gangs are moving into the area. When graffiti appears and is left up indefinitely, it sends a signal that people just don't care, which in turn attracts other forms of crime and delinquency to the neighborhood.

REPORT IT!

The City of Corona documents graffiti as a means to track criminal activity, including gangs and for evaluation and intelligence gathering. If you observe graffiti in you neighborhood contact the Graffiti Hotline (951) 817-5841. Make sure to leave your name, specific location

of graffiti and a phone number where you may be contacted for further information.

PREVENTION STRATEGIES



Most effective graffiti prevention efforts involve a combination of community education, citizen involvement and efficient removal

methods. In addition to laws and ordinances that are strictly enforced, a commitment to engage at-risk youth in positive activities within the community is crucial.

Whether graffiti is a random act of vandalism or deliberate communication between gang members, it is important to remove the graffiti as soon as it appears.
